

Treasurers Report

From 1 April 2019 to 30 September 2019

The bank account has increased by over £3000 in the 1st half of the year but a similar amount for the Sussex gymnastics championships are outstanding, awaiting invoices

More than 30 clubs are affiliated to the county and affiliation fees contributed more than £1000 to the bank account.

Woman's artistic had a successful invitation competition at Horsham and some of the proceeds from that are being used to fund county teams who have been invited to compete in Dorset at an inter county competition.

This year the tumble and DMT championships were held together at Hollington and went well, however unforeseen was the impact of the reduction in competitor numbers at both the trampoline and the gymnastics championships.

For the half year Trampoline returned more than £2000 to County funds however Gymnastics had an overspend from their championships. A detailed analysis on this was presented to the committee for discussion and to help with next year's planning.

There have been 3 funding contributions from the county, and a further one is awaiting documentation. The increase to £500 per club for training has been well received by those clubs that have applied. Further funds are available to all affiliated clubs go to the county web site for details.
