

Acrobatics Report October 2017

73 Pairs and Groups entered this year's Sussex Championships, across 5 different clubs. This is a similar number compared to last year. Having changed the rules last year to allow for 11-16, Junior and Senior Categories to enter, I was disappointed with the lack of uptake this year. Dependant on the number of entries in future competitions, I will consider whether it is reasonable to continue allowing these grades to participate if there is a lack of actual competition for gymnasts.

I have spoken to the committee before about setting up an acrobatics workshop, this has proved a little more time consuming than I had originally thought, and I have been unable to coordinate dates around competitions and getting people/clubs to share knowledge.

This is something I am still keen to pursue within the county, and now that Sussex Champs has finished for another year, I hope to be able to focus on this come January.

I still get very limited contact from clubs regarding Acrobatics enquiries or news. I assume this means all clubs are happy with how things are.
