

Sussex Gymnastics County Treasurers Report

From 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022

Up until the end of January Covid restrictions were in place and no activity took place.

The county committee following the lead of the region agreed to help support affiliated clubs during this time by giving a 2nd one off Covid grant. There were 24 applications including 2 additions to the 1st grants given the previous year.

In total the county supported its clubs in the year with £13,350 of grants from the county funds.

This money was taken from the county reserves that had been built up over the previous years, mainly from profits on competitions.

Since restarting there have been tumbling and trampoline competitions as well as a county squad established and these have returned £4000 to the county in additional generated income.

22 Clubs have now affiliated to the county for the coming year, and those affiliation fees of almost £1000 have been put back into the reserves
